

Junior Section Heat Policy

PURPOSE

Ensure and maintain the safety and enjoyment of Southern United Hockey Club members, parents, friends, coaches, managers and associated parties during training and games

Under 10 half field, Under 12, Under 14, Under 16 and Under 18

This only applies to scheduled training and activities. It does NOT apply to Hockey Victoria Scheduled Games. Hockey Victoria's heat policy can be found [here](#)

- A Scheduled Training will be cancelled at 3pm if at that point, the scheduled temperature for Moorabbin Airport at 5pm is to be above 35 degrees.
- It is the responsibility of the player's carer to use the Bureau of Meteorology website in order to determine if the temperature is schedule to be above 35 Degrees. A teamapp notification will normally also be sent out if training is to be cancelled.
- If a training on any given night is cancelled based on the forecast temperature then the training will not resume on that same night regardless of whether the temperature drops or not.
- If at any time during a scheduled training session the temperature is equal to or above 35 degrees then the training will cease and will not continue for that night.
- It is the responsibility of the coach/es, team manager or any SUHC Committee Members to be check the Moorabbin airport weather report on the BOM website or application to determine if temperature has reached over 35 Degrees.

The Junior Committee may, at its entire discretion, declare a Scheduled Training to be cancelled, ceased, abandoned, postponed or its schedule start or finish time otherwise affected, if it is reasonably satisfied that there may be severe weather conditions forecasted that are likely to affect training. The exercise of this discretion explicitly overrides everything else in this policy.

HOOKIN2HOCKEY AND SUHC UNDER 8 and UNDER 10 QF PROGRAM

- A Scheduled Training will be cancelled at 3pm if at that point, the scheduled temperature for Moorabbin Airport at 5pm is to be above 32 degrees. The meteye BOM website can be found at <https://bit.ly/2BMU8DR> (<http://www.bom.gov.au/places/vic/moorabbin-airport/>)
- It is the responsibility of the player's Carer to use the Bureau of Meteorology website in order to determine if the temperature is schedule to be above 32 Degrees.

- If at any time during a Scheduled training session the temperature is equal to or above 32 degrees then the training will cease and will not continue for that night.
- It is the responsibility of the coach/es, team manager or any SUHC Committee Members to be check the Moorabbin airport weather report on the BOM website or application to determine if temperature has reached over 32 Degrees.
